Agoura Hills:

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows several times this week.

OC canvassed Agoura Rd, T.O. Blvd and Kanan Rd. several times this week.

OC was notified by the city that an individual experiencing homelessness has been seen at Chumash Park early in the morning and throughout the day. OC and JT Manwell verified that the IND is A47. It does not appear that IND has an encampment. IND is pushing his belongings in a cart. OC to follow up. The city has been updated.

OC was notified that A57 was sighted at Lady Face Laundry. IND is a local and family was notified. IND may have been conserved by the state and recently at a facility in Pomona. OC is currently attempting to verify with DMH and will continue to investigate. Louis C, Deputy City Manager has been updated.

OC received a response from LAHOP # 79022. Two of the four INDs were contacted. One has accepted services. OC was unable to confirm which IND has accepted services but will contact INDs in the field and update.

Calabasas:

OC was informed that an IND experiencing homelessness was seen at Creekside Starbucks panhandling on Sunday. OC checked the location on Monday morning; however, the IND was not at the location.

OC canvassed Civic Center and checked in with Michael C, Deputy City Manager.

OC canvassed The Commons/Courtyard. C45 continues to loiter at the location and has been sleeping there overnight. MET is scheduled to make contact on Wednesday, May 15th.

OC checked in with SD De Matteo.

OC canvassed Calabasas Rd, Old Town Calabasas, and Parkway Calabasas several times this week.

OC checked in with Ravi, AGS Security. Nothing to report.

MET has cancelled an appointment to engage C45 a second time in two weeks. OC to follow up to schedule another appointment.

Hidden Hills:

OC canvassed Mureau Rd and checked the gazebo on Round Meadow several times this week.

OC checked in with security at Long Valley Gate. Nothing to report.

Malibu:
