Agoura Hills:

OC was notified that an IND experiencing homelessness panhandling near Latigo Kid. Oc confirmed that A39 returned to the area. IND remains service resistant. OC updated Louis C, Deputy City Manager.

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows shopping centers several times this week.

OC canvassed Agoura Rd, Kanan Rd, and T.O. Blvd. several times this week.

OC canvassed Old Agoura and Chumash Parks. No new contacts.

Daily check-in with JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison.

OC and JT canvassed Reyes Adobe Park and Forrest Cove Park.

Calabasas:

OC canvassed The Commons/Courtyard several times this week.

OC canvassed Civic Center and Calabasas Rd.

OC canvassed Creekside Village several times this week. OC did not locate any INDs dwelling in their vehicles.

OC met with Michael M, Deputy City Manager for check-in.

OC canvassed Park Grenada, Park Sorrento.

OC was notified that an individual experiencing homelessness may be camping at or near Gelsons. OC to canvass the area on Friday and make contact.

OC checked in with Allied Security at The Commons. Nothing new to report.

OC responded to a request from the city and located new contact: Male, 30s. IND was located near Gelsons and stated that he was waiting to connect with family who lives in the area. IND stated that he traveled from Woodland Hills. OC forwarded a list of resources and recommended IND reach out to a service provider if he was unable to connect with family. OC updated Michael M, Deputy City Manager.

Hidden Hills:

OC canvassed Mureau Rd. New contact: Male, 20s was engaged at the gazebo on Round Meadow. IND stated that he was passing through the area. IND was traveling on an e-scooter. OC forwarded a list of resources and suggested IND contact a service provider ASAP. IND showed some interest in receiving help.

OC checked in with security at Long Valley Gate. No new contacts.

Malibu:

OC canvassed Central Malibu.

OC canvassed Legacy Park. No encampments were located.

OC attended lunch. Approximately 40 INDs participated. New contact: Female, 40s. IND stated that she is from Arizona and traveling in an RV. IND stated that she is applying for jobs online. IND stated that she may not be staying in the area long enough for permanent housing services. OC to follow up.

OC attended lunch. Approximately 35 INDs participated. OC engaged M12 who has been homeless in the area for many decades. IND is working with TPC and has been matched to housing at two possible locations and is waiting for a vacancy. IND stated that he is ready to get off the streets.

OC engaged M91 who stated that he is working with TPC but has not talked about permanent housing. IND stated that he has a plan and does not intend to stay in the area for the time it takes to get housing. OC suggested IND consider housing services as a backup plan. OC to follow up.

Westlake Village:

OC canvassed Civic Center and checked in with city staff. Nothing new to report.

OC canvassed T.O. Blvd, Agoura Rd. and Lindero Canyon Rd. several times this week. No new contacts.

OC canvassed Shoppes at Westlake Village. No new contacts.
