### **Agoura Hills:**

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows several times this week.

OC canvassed Agoura Rd, T.O. Blvd and Kanan Rd several times this week.

Daily check-in with JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison.

OC canvassed Old Agoura and Chumash parks. No contacts.

OC located a possible individual experiencing homelessness at Kanan Starbucks. IND did not want to engage and was only in possession of a roll-away suitcase. OC to follow up next week if IND is still in the area.

OC checked in with Danny at Lady Face Laundry. Nothing new to report.

OC engaged A55 at City Hall. IND stated that he has not been matched to housing but needed to check in with his CM at Helping Hands. OC again suggested IND look into a Safe Parking program and forwarded contact information. OC to follow up.

### **Calabasas:**

OC was notified that an IND experiencing homelessness was seen over the weekend near Erewhon and Albertsons. OC canvassed the area including the business parks. OC was updated that IND was at the community center. OC engaged IND who was also engaged last week near Gelsons. IND stated that he is waiting for someone to pick him up. (C50) has not contacted a resource provider from the list OC forwarded. OC submitted LAHOP #82255 last week and is attempting to update the request. OC to follow up.

OC canvassed The Commons/Courtyard several times this week. No new contacts.

OC canvassed Creekside Village and nearby business parks.

OC was notified of an individual experiencing homelessness by AGS at Calabasas Rd and Parkway Calabasas. (C51) appeared disheveled and in poor condition. OC located IND on the HMIS System where IND has an extensive history. OC left a message with a point of contact at LAFH. Because IND was incontinent and was having a difficult time walking, emergency services were contacted. IND was transported to North Hills.

OC received a call from LAFH regarding C51 who was contacted on Wednesday. INDs CM was unaware IND had left the rehabilitation facility in LA and was very concerned. OC updated CM and stated IND was transported to North Hills. CM stated that he would reach out to the hospital. OC stated that if IND returned to the area, OC would inform CM. OC updated Michael M, Deputy City Manager.

### **Hidden Hills:**

OC canvassed Mureau Rd and checked the gazebo on Round Meadow several times this week.

OC checked in with security at Long Valley Gate. Nothing new to report.

### **Malibu:**

OC canvassed Central Malibu and Legacy Park. No encampments were located but many shopping carts are being left in the area during the day. OC to follow up with INDs experiencing homelessness to address the issue.

OC attended lunch. Approximately 40 INDs participated on Tuesday.

OC canvassed Heathercliff at Pavillions. No new contacts.

OC engaged M12 who continues to patiently wait for permanent housing. IND has been in the area for many years and is looking forward to getting off the streets.

OC engaged (M96) who has been dwelling in his vehicle in the area for several months. IND is working with TPC and is encouraged to begin the housing process. OC to follow up.

OC attended lunch on Thursday. Approximately 40 INDs participated.

### **Westlake Village:**

OC was notified of a IND who may be experiencing homelessness has been seen at the corner of Foxfield Dr. OC canvassed Foxfield Dr. at Lindero Canyon Rd. once on Saturday and twice on Monday. OC did not locate anyone. OC updated the city.

OC canvassed T.O. Blvd, Agoura Rd and Lindero Canyon Rd.

OC canvassed Shoppes at Westlake Village. No contacts.

OC canvassed Staples shopping center several times this week. No contacts.
