

## Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

### **August 26-30**

#### **Agoura Hills:**

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows shopping centers several times this week.

OC canvassed Agoura Rd, T.O. Blvd and Kanan Rd several times this week.

OC canvassed I-Hop shopping center.

OC notified Daniel M, MET that A60 had returned to the library. IND arrived early in the morning and stated that she spent the night outside and was shivering. IND stated that she wanted help and appeared to be deteriorating physically. City staff waited with IND while OC contacted the Psychiatric Mobile Response Team. PMRT met with IND and were concerned about her safety. PMRT placed IND on a medical hold. OC to follow up.

OC received a request from JT Manwell regarding an IND who was seen camping on Roadside St. OC and JT engaged IND who accepted a list of resources. IND stated that he was working with the county, but the housing list is too long. OC to follow up. IND was not seen in the area on Friday.

OC and JT Manwell attempted to contact an IND who parked an RV at the Park and Ride at Roadside. IND did not respond to engagement. It is not clear if IND was at the location. JT to contact Cal Trans for jurisdiction. OC and JT made a second attempt on Friday without success.
