

Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

September 3-6

Agoura Hills:

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows shopping centers several times this week. No new contacts.

OC and JT Manwell engaged IND male (A61) on Canwood and was informed that the city is working on acquiring an LOA for the property where IND is camped. IND is service resistant but was given a list of resources. JT followed up on Wed. IND was not at the location.

OC and JT Manwell located a vehicle that appeared to be a dwelling in a parking lot on Agoura Rd. IND was not at the location on Wed.

Daniel M, MET notified OC that a female dwelling in her vehicle reached out for assistance. An LAHOP was submitted on Wed. OC to wait until contact is made by LAHSA Outreach. OC to follow up.

OC was notified that an IND experiencing homelessness may be sleeping in Old Agoura Park. OC canvassed the area and engaged an IND who stated that he is a local resident and likes to read in the park and is not staying overnight. OC updated JT Manwell.

Calabasas:

OC canvassed The Commons/Courtyard several times this week. No new contacts.

OC canvassed Civic Center and met with Michael M, Deputy City Manager for updates.

OC responded to a request submitted on the city website outreach portal. IND resides in Malibu and is known to OC. M35 was under the impression that there was a Safe Parking provider in the Calabasas area. OC clarified and forwarded contact information for Safe Parking LA and N. Valley Caring Services that also operate a similar program. IND later stated that he filled out the applications online. OC to follow up.

OC canvassed Gates Canyon Park. No contacts.

OC was contacted by AGS regarding an IND with a shopping cart and was seen walking up Calabasas Rd. OC stated that he was not in the area on Friday and would attempt to locate IND on Monday.

Hidden Hills:

OC checked in with security at Long Valley Gate. No new contacts.

OC canvassed Mureau Rd and checked the gazebo on Round Meadow several times this week.

Malibu:

OC responded to a request submitted on the Calabasas outreach portal. IND resides in Malibu and is known to OC. M35 was under the impression that there was a Safe Parking provider in the Calabasas area. OC clarified and forwarded contact information for Safe Parking LA and N. Valley Caring Services who operate a similar program. IND later stated that he filled out the applications online. OC to follow up.

OC participated in a Google Meets with Luis F, Public Safety Liaison regarding the upcoming outreach and engagement to take place on PCH at Coastline. Approximately 3-4 RVs will be offered services on September 9th and notified that a cleanup will occur later in the year.

OC engaged M10 to ask if he wanted TPC to transport him to the DMV on Wednesday. IND declined at the time but does want to acquire his ID. OC updated Jimmy, Outreach CM. IND is considering accepting a bed at Turning Point. IND has been service resistant for many years but is considering making a change.

OC canvassed Central Malibu and engaged M35 who contacted Safe Parking LA. IND stated that there are conflicts that prevent him from utilizing their services. OC to follow up.

Westlake Village:

OC canvassed Civic Center and checked in with city staff. Nothing to report.

OC canvassed Agoura Rd, T.O. Blvd and Lindero Canyon Rd several times this week.

OC canvassed Shoppes at Westlake Village and Staples shopping center several times this week.

OC was contacted by SD Knott regarding an IND that matches the description of A47 who has a small encampment near Agoura Rd. IND was notified that he could not remain at the location which is private property. OC attempted to locate IND on Friday without success. IND has been service resistant. OC to follow up.

OC canvassed Westlake Village Community Park. No contacts.
