Agoura Hills:

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows several times this week.

OC canvassed Kanan Rd, T.O. Blvd and Agoura Rd several times this week. No new contacts.

Daily check-in with JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison.

OC engaged A42 at Lady Face Laundry so see if IND is interested in utilizing a bed at SFVCMHC. IND stated that he was not interested at this time but would maybe consider the opportunity in the future. OC to follow up.

OC canvassed I-Hop parking lot. No new contacts.

OC canvassed Old Agoura and Chumash Parks. No contacts.

Calabasas:

OC canvassed The Commons/Courtyard several times this week. No new contacts.

OC canvassed Civic Center several times this week.

OC engaged new contact at Civic Center. Female, 40s. IND was sitting on the steps and had been in the area over the weekend. OC attempted to engage. IND stated that she was okay and would not accept a list of resources. IND later engaged with Allied Security and asked about a food bank location. Allied gave IND a list of resources. OC followed up with Allied Security on Tuesday. IND was not seen in the area.

OC was contacted by SD Saucedo regarding new contact. Male, 30s. IND stated that he was recently released from custody and has family in the area. OC informed IND of housing programs available for INDs in his situation and suggested IND reach out to a service provider ASAP. OC also suggested IND consider a substance abuse program. IND accepted a list of resources.

OC engaged new contact near the gazebo at Creekside Village. IND stated that he is not experiencing homelessness and works full-time in the area. IND lives an hour away and is planning on purchasing a vehicle this weekend so that he can commute back and forth. OC to follow up.

OC located C34 on the hill side behind Civic Center. IND is stashing his belongings behind the retaining wall, and it is not clear if IND is sleeping in the area overnight. IND remains service resistant. OC updated Michael M, Deputy City Manager and SD De Matteo.

Hidden Hills:

OC checked in with security at Long Valley Gate. Nothing new to report.

OC canvassed Mureau Rd. and checked the gazebo on Round Meadow several times this week.

Malibu:

OC engaged M93 and discussed working with TPC Outreach and begin the housing process. IND appeared more receptive to services and agreed to meet with Jimmy on Thursday. OC to follow up.

OC engaged M13 to discuss housing. IND remains service resistant but acknowledged it is becoming more difficult with age to live outside. OC to follow up.

OC engaged M79 to follow up regarding working with TPC. IND was recently released from custody and qualifies for housing. OC reminded IND that there is a time limit to qualify for that specific program. OC to follow up.

OC attended lunch. Approximately 30 INDs participated on Tuesday and Thursday.

OC canvassed Legacy Park. No encampments were located.

OC checked in with SD Espinoza.

Westlake Village:

OC canvassed T.O. Blvd, Agoura Rd, and Lindero Canyon Rd several times this week. No new contacts.

OC canvassed Staples Shopping center and checked in with the restaurant owner who stated that he has had no further issues with INDs experiencing homelessness recently.

OC canvassed Civic Center and checked in with staff.
