The suspect got into his vehicle and accelerated his vehicle toward the victim in an attempt to hit the victim. The victim was able to dodge the vehicle. Later, the suspect was seen attempting to steal a vehicle on Tiner Court, where he was apprehended.

Two suspects, residents of Los Angeles and Venice, were arrested for residential burglary on Malibu Road. They used bodily force on the rear door to gain entry. The victim's property was recovered.

SCHOOL ISSUES

- Conducted safety walkthrough at Our Lady of Malibu School
- Conducted safety walkthrough at Malibu Elementary School
- Conducted Critical Scenario tabletop exercise for Our Lady of Malibu School staff members.

INTERVENTIONS

Follow-up with juvenile and parents regarding burglary case.

COMMUNITY / CRIMINAL ISSUES

1. We spoke with numerous citizens and parents who called to question various juvenile concerns and issues in the community. We also provide the parents with resource programs within our community.
2. We inquired with the Sylmar Juvenile Court District Attorney regarding the investigation and filing of criminal charges against juvenile offenders.
3. Met with Captain Jennifer Seetoo throughout the month to keep her up to date regarding our unit's investigations and current juvenile issues within our city.
4. Entered juveniles into the Youth Diversion program for various violations.
5. We investigated, prepared, and filed cases with the District Attorney's office. We additionally assisted other investigators in the preparation of cases for court.
6. Met with station narcotic detectives to exchange information regarding juvenile and drug related issues.
7. Handled the processing and follow-up of various juvenile referrals brought to the attention of this unit for various juvenile contacts with uniform personnel.
8. Conducted our normal checks of juvenile problem areas in the city during weekend evenings and responded to juvenile related calls for service.
9. Assisted Patrol re: CARP, backfill behind patrol/shortage, mandatory overtime.
10. Conducted transient monthly sex registration for 290 registrants in the city of Malibu jurisdiction.
11. Follow up investigation regarding Malibu Elementary burglary case.
12. Participated in Active Shooter training at Pepperdine University.
13. Follow-up investigations regarding assault case in city of Malibu.
