### **January 21-24**

#### **Agoura Hills:**

OC engaged A63 on Saturday at the old Islands Restaurant. 63, Female who stated that she was not picked up by the shuttle for shelter. OC attempted to locate a winter shelter bed throughout LA County without success. IND may be willing to accept interim housing. OC to follow up.

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows several times this week. No new contacts.

OC canvassed Agoura Rd, T.O. Blvd and Kanan Rd several times this week. No new contacts.

OC followed up with A63 on Wednesday at McDonalds. IND stated that she is planning on traveling to Ventura in the coming days. OC to follow up on Friday.

New contact: Male, 30s. IND not interested in services. IND was panhandling at 7/11. IND was not at the location later in the afternoon. IND may be traveling with another IND who was later engaged at Westlake Village. OC to follow up.

OC contacted LAFH Outreach regarding LAHOP #91190 (A63). A team is scheduled to contact IND on Friday.

OC and JT Manwell transported A63 to SFVCMHC to complete her intake for services at the access center. IND to return on Monday for further appointments which will enable IND to transition into interim housing. OC continues to coordinate with SFVCMHC. OC updated Louis C, Deputy City Manager.

#### **Calabasas:**

OC canvassed The Commons/Courtyard several times this week.

OC canvassed Civic Center several times this week and checked in with city staff.

OC canvassed Creekside Village several times this week. New contact. Male, 30s. IND dwelling in his vehicle. OC forwarded a list of resources and discussed Safe Parking programs. IND was interested and stated that he would reach out to all service providers. OC to follow up.

OC was notified by Allied Security of an IND sleeping on the grass at Parkway Calabasas. OC attempted to engage IND who was not responsive and would not accept a list of service providers. IND eventually walked toward Calabasas Rd. and has not been seen in the area as of Friday afternoon.

### **Hidden Hills:**

OC checked in with security at Long Valley Gate. Nothing new to report.

OC canvassed Mureau Rd. several times this week. No new contacts.

### **Malibu:**

OC canvassed Central Malibu. New contact. Male, 60s. IND stated that he had been displaced from the Palisades Fire. IND stated that he works with TPC Palisades.

OC attended lunch on Tuesday and Thursday. Approximately 10 INDs participated on both occasions.

OC transported M93 to the DMV in Thousand Oaks to retrieve paperwork. IND continues to deny services with TPC.

OC canvassed Central Malibu. Shopping carts continue to accumulate in Legacy Park as the recent cart retrieval was canceled due to the Palisades Fire. The Sheriff contacted IND regarding his tent and IND agreed to take it down.

### **Westlake Village:**

OC canvassed Agoura Rd, T.O. Blvd and Lindero Canyon Rd. several times this week.

OC canvassed Civic Center and checked in with city staff.

OC canvassed Shoppes at Westlake Village. New contact. Male, 30s IND was not interested in services and stated that he was traveling to San Diego.

OC was notified that an IND experiencing homelessness may be loitering in the wash near Lindero Canyon Rd. IND stated that he has spoken with OC previously. IND does not have an encampment. OC to follow up.
