

Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

January 27-31

Agoura Hills:

OC and JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison transported A63 to SFVCMHC. IND received a voucher for her ID which she needs prior to being placed in housing. IND stated that she wants to move closer to the access center so she can utilize their services more conveniently. OC to follow up.

OC canvassed Kanan Rd. New contact: Male, 60s. IND stated that he is traveling through the area and is a veteran. IND not interested in services.

OC spoke to Charlie R, SFVCMHC who stated that the center can assist with transportation via ride sharing app for A63. OC to inquire from IND on Wednesday if she would like to go to the DMV.

OC was contacted by Jonah G. from Supervisor Horvath's office who was able to locate a bed for A63 in Sylmar. IND accepted shelter and OC submitted the referral. OC and JT Manwell transported IND to Sylmar where the intake was completed. OC updated Louis C, Deputy City Manager, Charlie R, SFVCMHC and Terry D, COG Executive Director.

Calabasas:

OC canvassed The Commons/Courtyard several times this week.

OC canvassed Civic Center. No new contacts.

OC canvassed Creekside Village several times this week.

OC checked in with Michael M, Deputy City Manager. OC checked under the Agoura St Bridge. New contact: Male, 30s. IND stated that he is traveling to Ventura to stay with his dad but missed the last bus the night before. OC informed IND that there is a cleanup scheduled for Friday. IND is service resistant. OC updated Michael M.

OC attended the Agoura Bridge cleanup along with Allied Security and City Staff. No IND was at the location upon arrival.



Hidden Hills:

OC checked in with Long Valley Gate. An IND experiencing homelessness attempted to enter the city on Sunday. IND wanted to short cut through the community. IND left without incident.

OC canvassed Mureau Rd. several times this week.

OC followed up with the guards at Long Valley Gate regarding the IND who was attempting to enter the community on Monday and Tuesday. IND has not been seen in several days.

Malibu:

OC canvassed Central Malibu and engaged M110. IND stated that he is planning on attending classes at Pepperdine but needs paperwork to show residence. OC suggested IND work with TPC Outreach. IND is planning on visiting the access center in Santa Monica.

OC attended lunch on Tuesday. 5 INDs participated.

OC attended lunch on Thursday. Approximately 10 INDs participated.

TPC Palisades Outreach was in the area contacting several clients that were displaced from the fire.

Westlake Village:

OC canvassed the wooded area next to the wash at Lindero Canyon and Agoura Rd. No encampment or IND was located at the site. The locks on the gates have been replaced. OC updated Caleb M. Assistant to the City Manager.

OC canvassed Smart and Final shopping center. New contact: Male, 20s. IND stated that he is employed and is taking advantage of an employee assistance program. IND is service resistant.



OC engaged IND walking on Russell Ranch Rd. IND may have been loitering in the wash in recent days. IND stated that he has been trying to go north but is not familiar with the Metro Bus routes. OC offered IND a ride to the transit center in T.O. IND accepted.
