- Investigated social media bullying and concerning posts made by students at Our Lady of Malibu. No crime. Notified school staff and advised they would counsel the student.

INTERVENTIONS

COMMUNITY / CRIMINAL ISSUES

- J-Team responded to a major brush fire in the mid-Malibu area.
- Conducted training sessions with Malibu School staff regarding lockdown terminology, procedures, and scenarios.
- A shelter-in-place drill was observed at Malibu High and Middle School
- The J-Team spoke with numerous citizens and parents who called to question juvenile concerns and community issues. We also provided the parents with resource programs within our community.
- The J-Team attended a web-based investigation training at the Joint Regional Intelligence Center in the City of Industry.
- The J-Team contacted the Sylmar Juvenile Court District Attorney to inquire about the investigation and potential criminal charges against juvenile offenders.
- During the month, we met with Captain Jennifer Seetoo to discuss our unit's investigations and the current issues involving juveniles in our city.
- The collaboration was done with investigators to prepare court cases and investigations for case filings with the District Attorney's office.
- Juvenile referrals related to encounters with uniformed personnel were conducted.
- Patrols of juvenile problem areas in the city occurred on weekend evenings and responded to juvenile-related calls for service.
- The J-Team ensured record sealing procedures were initiated for subjects who completed CHAMPS diversion for minor offenses.
- The J-Team aided in patrolling for CARP, filled in for any patrol shortages, and worked mandatory overtime.
- 290 residential verifications for sex registrants were conducted.
