Agoura Hills:

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows several times this week.

OC canvassed I-Hop shopping center several times this week.

OC canvassed Agoura Rd, T.O. Blvd and Kanan Rd several times this week.

OC canvassed Civic Center several times this week and met with Louis C. Deputy City Manager for updates.

OC was informed that A65 has found a place to stay with a friend and is no longer seeking shelter. IND was grateful for the assistance OC and JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison offered to PEH.

OC received a request to check the foot bridge above the 101 Fwy. Between Canwood st. and Roadside St. OC checked the site on Thursday, and it does not appear that PEH is not staying on the bridge. Photo included.



OC canvassed Roadside St. near the 101 freeway to verify that there are no vehicles being dwelled in near the area. OC checked the location in the early morning twice this week. OC updated Louis C.

OC left a VM with SD Sheklo, HOST Team for follow up on the encampment under the 101 Fwy. The area has not been cleaned up.

Calabasas:

OC canvassed The Commons/Courtyard several times this week.

OC canvassed Civic Center several times this week and met with Michael M. Deputy City Manager for updates.

OC canvassed Calabasas Rd. and checked the bus stops on Parkway Calabasas for PEH. No contacts.

OC canvassed Creekside Village and checked under the Agoura St. Bridge several times this week.

New contact: Male, age unknown. IND was sleeping on the sidewalk in front of McDonalds. OC forwarded a list of resources. IND was not at the location as of Thursday morning.

OC was notified that PEH are sleeping alongside the Albertsons building as well as several INDs dwelling in their vehicle. OC canvassed the parking lot and did not discover any PEH camping near the building. However, one PEH was located dwelling in their van. OC offered a list of resources which was declined and informed PEH about Safe Park LA. Another IND was located who stated that he is not experiencing homelessness but works in the area and to save gas money, stays in the area Monday through Friday. OC updated Michael M.

Hidden Hills:

OC canvassed Mureau Rd several times this week. No contacts.

OC checked in with security at Long Valley Gate.

Malibu:

OC engaged M113 who mentioned that he is thinking about returning to Hawaii but has not made a commitment. IND remains service resistant. OC will continue to engage PEH.

OC canvassed Central Malibu. No new PEH were in the area.

OC engaged M93 who has a new injury on his face. IND stated that he was in a fight recently. OC continues to encourage PEH to consider a residential treatment program. OC to follow up.

OC engaged M93 to encourage PEH to enroll in a Residential Treatment program. IND agreed and met with TPC to set up a time next week. IND must attend detox prior to entering treatment. OC to contact PEH over the weekend to remind him of his appointment on Monday with TPC.
