SCHOOL INCIDENTS

- Juvenile Team on Vacation 12/24/24-01/04/25
- Palisades Fire Started 01/07/2025
 - Assisted in evacuations, road closures, missing person investigations, death investigations, looter suppression, and command post support.

INTERVENTIONS

COMMUNITY / CRIMINAL ISSUES

- The Malibu HS/MS lockdown drill was canceled due to the fire.
- Follow up investigation of a Malibu robbery and carjacking incident that resulted in a vehicle pursuit and arrest of all juveniles involved. All Juveniles were detained at the Los Padrinos detention center.
- Arrested suspect in Malibu area for false report of an emergency. A suspect was also arrested for outstanding warrants.
- Conducted a surveillance operation for an adult selling cannabis products to juveniles in the Malibu area. The investigation is ongoing.
- Authored a supplemental report for the case closure of a battery incident in the Malibu area between 12-year-old juveniles. The investigation determined the incident to be mutual battery.
- Authored court documents to aid in the investigation of sales of cannabis products to a juvenile.
- Contacted LASD Print shop and picked up critical facilities information booklets created by J Team. All patrol vehicles will be supplied with a booklet to facilitate the response to critical incidents.
- Compiled Juvenile arrest data for the 4th quarter of 2024 and sent the information to the Department of Youth Development.
- The J-Team contacted the Sylmar Juvenile Court District Attorney to inquire about the investigation and potential criminal charges against juvenile offenders.
- During the month, we met with Captain Jennifer Seetoo to discuss our unit's investigations and the current issues involving juveniles in our city.
- The collaboration was done with investigators to prepare court cases and investigations for case filings with the District Attorney's office.
- Juvenile referrals related to encounters with uniformed personnel were conducted.
- Patrols of juvenile problem areas in the city occurred on weekend evenings and responded to juvenile-related calls for service.

- The J-Team ensured record sealing procedures were initiated for subjects who completed CHAMPS diversion for minor offenses.
- 290 residential verifications for sex registrants were conducted.
