

Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

Agoura Hills:

OC located the small encampment on the property at Cornell. PEH was not at the location at the time. The city is working with the property owner and LHSD to schedule a cleanup. A Letter of Agency is on file with the Sheriff. OC to follow up.

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows shopping centers several times this week. JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison informed OC that A06 was seen near Vons. PEH stated that he is staying and working in the San Fernando Valley.

OC canvassed Kanan Rd, T.O. Blvd and Agoura Rd several times this week.

OC and JT Manwell met with LHSD HOST Team and CHP to check the encampment under the 101 Fwy. Between Canwood and Roadside St. The jurisdiction at the location has not been determined yet. OC to follow up with HOST early next week.

Calabasas:

OC was contacted by the LAFH Outreach team that responded to LAHOP #92454 last weekend. Outreach stated that they were unable to locate PEH. OC informed the team that the PEH as not been seen at the location for several weeks.

OC canvassed The Commons/Courtyard several times this week.

OC canvassed Calabasas Rd, Parkway Calabasas and Old Town.

OC canvassed Creekside Village and checked under the Agoura St. Bridge several times this week. No new contacts.

OC canvassed Lost Hills Rd, Malibu Hills Rd and Shadow Hills Rd. No new contacts.

OC engaged Female, 40s at the bus stop at Calabasas Rd and Parkway Calabasas. It is the same PEH that was at the location several weeks ago. PEH did not wish to engage with OC. OC updated Allied Security and Deputy De Matteo. OC to follow up.

OC engaged new contact at Creekside Village behind Albertsons. PEH was dwelling in his vehicle. OC offered a list of resources and suggested Safe Park LA. OC to follow up.

Malibu:

OC located a small tent at Legacy Park. New contact: Female, 20s. IND stated that she set up the tent because rain was forecasted for the area. PEH stated that she was in a hurry to catch the bus for a court appointment. PEH unhooked the poles and will pack up the tent later. OC to follow up.

New contact: Male, 50s. PEH stated that he has been in the area a week. PEH stated that he has a plan and is waiting for some funding that will help get him on his feet. OC informed PEH of additional temporary funding that may be available through TPC. OC updated TPC outreach and will follow up.

OC notified PEH at the Library and Legacy Park of the upcoming cart retrieval scheduled for Thursday, March 6th at 10am.

OC engaged M109 at Starbucks. IND is interested in Sober Living and is looking for a Palisades Fire cleanup job. A volunteer at lunch gathered PEH information and will ask her contacts if they are looking for a handyman.

OC attended lunch on Tuesday and Thursday. Approximately 10 PEH attended.

OC assisted with the scheduled shopping cart retrieval on Thursday. TPC was on location handing out City Packs for PEH in exchange for the carts. 8 carts were retrieved and all PEH were cooperative.

OC canvassed Legacy Park. No new encampments were located.

Westlake Village:

OC canvassed Civic Center at 6am several times this week. No PEH were in the parking lot.

OC canvassed Smart and Final shopping center several times this week.

OC canvassed Agoura Rd, T.O. Blvd and Lindero Canyon Rd. several times this week.

OC was informed that an PEH was sleeping near a back door at the Civic Center on Tuesday. OC followed up on Wednesday, however PEH was not at the location.
