**SCHOOL INCIDENTS**

- Malibu High School: “Samohi Walkout” Trump protest. Prepared event action plan and conducted operation to ensure the safety of all participants.
- Malibu High School: Conducted a follow up regarding a student who is habitually truant. The student is known to have mental health concerns. The parents have a safety plan in place and DCFS was notified to conduct a follow up at the residence.
- Malibu High School: Conducted a follow up regarding a student who is habitually truant. The student is known to have mental health concerns. This is an ongoing issue involving a custody dispute between parents and DCFS involvement. The J-Team is monitoring the issue.

**INTERVENTIONS**

**COMMUNITY / CRIMINAL ISSUES**

- Contacted and arrested an adult in the city of Malibu for selling cannabis products to minors. The arrest is a result of an ongoing investigation that began in October 2024.
- The J-Team was advised of a DUI traffic collision that occurred on Kanan Road. The incident was handled by CHP. The subject involvement was Malibu HS students.
- Supplied all Lost Hills patrol vehicles with current and updated critical facilities information booklets.
- Compiled Juvenile arrest data for the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of 2024 and sent the information to Department of Youth Development.
- The J-Team contacted the Sylmar Juvenile Court District Attorney to inquire about the investigation and potential criminal charges against juvenile offenders.
- During the month, we met with Captain Jennifer Seetoo to discuss our unit's investigations and the current issues involving juveniles in our city.
- The collaboration was done with investigators to prepare court cases and investigations for case filings with the District Attorney's office.
- Juvenile referrals related to encounters with uniformed personnel were conducted.
- Patrols of juvenile problem areas in the city occurred on weekend evenings and responded to juvenile-related calls for service.
- The J-Team ensured record sealing procedures were initiated for subjects who completed CHAMPS diversion for minor offenses.
- 290 residential verifications for sex registrants were conducted.
