**SCHOOL INCIDENTS**

- Malibu High School: A student with repeated truancies, school staff had concerns regarding the mother's mental health. DCFS advised they would visit the residence.
- Malibu High School: Possible bullying incident regarding a male juvenile who was recently arrested for a DUI with injuries. School staff will closely monitor the students involved and notify the J-Team of any further incidents.
- Malibu High School: Possible cocaine sales within the student body. Students were interviewed and no controlled substances were recovered. The investigation is ongoing.
- Pepperdine University: Prepared for planned protest at regarding "Charlie Kirk" event.

**INTERVENTIONS**

**COMMUNITY / CRIMINAL ISSUES**

- A warrant package was prepared for an investigation regarding sales of cannabis to a minor.
- Follow up conversation with DCFS regarding a Malibu High student that was habitually truant. DCFS advised they have not been able to make contact but will continue to make attempts.
- Conducted follow up conversations with subjects involved in criminal threat incidents in the past. Follow ups were completed to ensure the safety of the community.
- Contacted staff at the Middle Schools and High Schools in the area to educate them about electric bicycle laws. Provided the staff with material to educate their students about electric bicycle laws and safety.
- Assisted station detectives with a location search warrant regarding an assault with a deadly weapon investigation. The assault occurred in the city of Malibu. The warrant service was successful, evidence was gathered, and the suspect was arrested.
- Counseled a Malibu High student regarding habitual truancies and drug use. The student was receptive to counseling.
- The J-Team contacted the Sylmar Juvenile Court District Attorney to inquire about the investigation and potential criminal charges against juvenile offenders.
- Meetings with Captain Jennifer Seetoo to discuss our unit's investigations and current issues involving juveniles.
- The collaboration was done with investigators to prepare court cases and investigations for case filings with the District Attorney's office.
- Juvenile referrals related to encounters with uniformed personnel were conducted.
- Patrols of juvenile problem areas in the city occurred on weekend evenings.
- The J-Team ensured record sealing procedures were initiated for subjects who completed CHAMPS diversion for minor offenses.
