

Outreach Coordinator Weekly Update

Agoura Hills:

OC canvassed Civic Center parking lot at 6:08. No PEH were sleeping in their vehicles at the time.

OC canvassed Twin Oaks and Agoura Meadows shopping center and engaged new contact: Male, 30s. PEH was standing in front of Citi Bank. PEH stated that he is from San Deigo and may be interested in shelter. PEH stated that he has an ID and stated that he may leave the area. OC stated that if PEH is in the area on Wed and is still interested in shelter, we will arrange for a ride to Corner Stone. OC to follow up.

OC canvassed T.O. Blvd, Agoura Rd and Kanan Rd several times this week.

OC engaged A67 at Ralphs. PEH is interested in shelter. OC and JT Manwell, Public Safety Liaison transported PEH to SFVCMHC where he completed his intake. A67 has a follow up appointment on Monday the 24th and can transport himself to the facility. OC will send a reminder on Sunday.

Calabasas:

OC engaged PEH, Female, 40s at 7:50 am. PEH was occupying a bench in front of Blackbird General Store and utilizing a wall outlet to charge her phone. PEH is the same IND that has been sleeping on a bus bench at Calabasas Rd. and Parkway Calabasas. PEH remains service resistant. OC updated SD De Matteo. OC submitted LAHOP #94136

OC canvassed Creekside Village and engaged M93 who recently left Malibu and has been staying in the Calabasas/Agoura Hills area. OC has been working with PEH for some time and almost placed PEH in a Detox/Residential treatment program. PEH backed out at the last minute. PEH remains service resistant.

OC engaged C07 on Malibu Hills Rd. PEH continues to maintain two vehicles. OC offered to assist PEH empty one so he can drive his belongings to his storage. PEH stated that he needs to install a shelf first. PEH has been dwelling in his vehicle for 9 years. OC submitted LAHOP #94066. OC to follow up.

OC checked under both sides of the Agoura Rd. Bridge and canvassed Creekside Village at 6:30 am on Monday.

OC engaged new contact. Male, 60s. PEH stated that he is not interested in shelter at this time. OC located PEH on Tuesday a second time and submitted LAHOP # 94138.

OC canvassed Gelson's parking lot. No contacts.

LA Family Housing responded to LAHOP # 94066 and contacted C07. The outreach will continue working with PEH to establish a relationship and offer services.

LA Family Housing responded to LAHOP #94138 and contacted PEH who was sleeping on the bench in front of Coffee Bean. PEH walked away after a brief engagement.

OC connected C60 to LAFH Outreach who offered PEH a bed in shared housing. PEH was displaced from the Palisades Fire. PEH accepted the housing opportunity and will view the unit on Friday March 21. PEH also received a grant from The Rotary Club which will assist with the hotel stay until move in date which will take approximately 1 week. OC updated Michael M, Deputy City Manager.

Barry, Outreach Case Manager from LA Family Housing notified OC that C60s unit viewing went well on Friday. PEH expected to move in next Monday or Tuesday. OC left a VM with C60.

Hidden Hills:

OC checked in with security at Long Valley Gate. No new contacts to report.

OC canvassed Mureau Rd several times this week. No new contacts.

Malibu:

OC canvassed Trancas Market. No new contacts.

OC canvassed Zuma beach and the wooded area near the entrance. No contacts or encampments were located.

OC informed M117 about TPC Outreach and showed interest in services. OC updated TPC Outreach and will attempt to locate next week.
