SCHOOL INCIDENTS

- A critical operation was conducted at Pepperdine University for a juvenile missing in the area. The juvenile was found and returned to her family.
- Provided security and monitored a lawful protest at Pepperdine University regarding a “Jordan Peterson” appearance on campus. The protest was peaceful and lawful.
- Possible BB gun on Malibu Elementary School grounds. Deemed as a notification only. The school will notify the J Team of any updates.

INTERVENTIONS

COMMUNITY / CRIMINAL ISSUES

- Conducted a follow-up investigation for an assault investigation at a Malibu treatment center.
- Participated in cell phone investigation training at the LA HIDTA field office in Commerce. Covered investigative topics such as GPS location, cell phone dump, and social media search techniques.
- Participated in “meet and greet” event at Ventura County Sheriff’s office. Discussed current crime issues (Burglary, Theft) in the Ventura County and Malibu/Lost Hills Area.
- Participated in search warrant entry training hosted by the Santa Clarita Sheriff’s Station.
- Contacted several juveniles regarding the illegal use of e-motorcycles. Educated several juveniles and confiscated several e-motorcycles in accordance with the California Vehicle Code.
- Participated in the State Attendance Review Board hearing with LVUSD. Interviewed several students and families struggling with truancy issues to find a solution to habitual truancy.
- Participated in a meeting for the preparation of the annual Active Shooter Training for Lost Hills Station.
- Collaborated with the new Deputy District Attorney in Charge at Sylmar court to discuss more efficient procedures for case filings with the District Attorney's office.
- Participated in the Annual Malibu/Lost Hills Open House Event.
- Participated in quarterly firearm qualification in accordance with department policy.
- Juvenile referrals related to encounters with uniformed personnel were conducted.
- Patrols of juvenile problem areas in the city occurred on weekend evenings and responded to juvenile-related calls for service.
- The J-Team ensured record sealing procedures were initiated for subjects who completed CHAMPS diversion for minor offenses.
- 290 residential verifications for sex registrants were conducted.
