SCHOOL INCIDENTS

- Initiated a felony vandalism investigation involving several students and non-students who vandalized Malibu High School, causing several thousand dollars' worth of damage.
- Conducted several interviews with students in Malibu High School who were involved in vandalism.
- Conducted interviews with several staff members regarding vandalism in Malibu High School.

INTERVENTIONS

COMMUNITY / CRIMINAL ISSUES

- Participated in the State Attendance Review Board hearing with LVUSD. Interviewed students and families struggling with truancy issues to find a solution to habitual truancy.
- Preparation for the annual Active Shooter Training for Lost Hills Station.
- Collaborated with the new Deputy District Attorney in charge at Sylmar Court to discuss more efficient procedures for case filings with the District Attorney's office.
- Participated in quarterly firearm qualification in accordance with Department policy.
- During the month, we met with Captain Jennifer Seetoo and A/Captain Carr to discuss our unit's investigations and the current issues involving juveniles in our city.
- Juvenile referrals related to encounters with uniformed personnel were conducted.
- Patrols of juvenile problem areas in the city occurred on weekend evenings and responded to juvenile-related calls for service.
- The J-Team ensured record sealing procedures were initiated for subjects who completed CHAMPS diversion for minor offenses.
- 290 residential verifications for sex registrants were conducted.
