Agoura Hills:

The encampment at the Kano property has been removed. SD HOST team will check the area within thirty days to ensure the camp has not been re-established.



Calabasas:

OC engaged C65 at Starbucks in The Commons. PEH stated that he did not need help because his father is supposed to contact him today. PEH stated that SDs contacted him to inform him that he is not to contact his mother directly. PEH may have family in the area. OC submitted LAHOP # 99974. OC to follow up.

Hidden Hills:

OC checked in with security at Long Valley Gate. Nothing to report.

OC canvassed Mureau Rd. several times this week. No new contacts.

Malibu:

OC canvassed Central Malibu on Monday and Thursday.

OC informed PEH that the cart retrieval will be postponed to Tuesday, July 22nd.

OC engaged M94 who stated that he attempted to get his Birth Certificate from out of state without success. OC suggested he continue to engage with TPC Outreach for housing. OC to follow up.

OC canvassed Trancas Country Market. No new contacts.

OC canvassed the Zuma Beach Boardwalk. No new contacts.

OC attended lunch on Thursday. Approximately 15 PEH participated.

OC engaged M10 at Legacy Park. PEH stated that he is going to talk to TPC Outreach about the possibility of returning to Turning Point. PEH regrets leaving. OC to follow up.

OC engaged M06 on Cross Creek. PEH stated that he wants to stay on the housing list and is going to engage with TPC Outreach on Thursday. OC followed up with PEH later in the day. He stated that he was able to connect with Jimmy and Will.

Westlake Village:

OC engaged W09 at Starbucks and gave PEH a City Pack. PEH stated that he is moving to the Thousand Oaks area to establish a local address which is required to qualify for most services there, including the Tiny Home Village. OC also forwarded local resource information. OC to follow up.

OC was informed that several PEH homelessness have been seen in the area on Thursday, including W08. OC to canvass the area again on Friday and will update.

OC canvassed Westlake Village Community Park/YMCA. No contacts.

OC engaged new contact near Petco early in the am. Male, 40s. PEH stated that he is passing through the area and heading into Los Angeles. PEH was seen a short time later at the bus stop on T.O. Blvd.

OC canvassed TJ Max shopping center early Friday morning and again early in the afternoon. No contacts.

OC canvassed Duncan Doughnuts early Friday morning and again in the afternoon. OC engaged W08. OC asked PEH if he had a T.O. address in the past as he would qualify for interim housing at the T.O. Tiny Home Village. PEH stated that he has not and remains service resistant.

OC canvassed the areas near Panera Bread, and Tikka Grill. No contacts.

OC canvassed Montessori of the Village. No contacts.

OC and Mike W, Public Safety Liaison, canvassed the green belt near the 101 FWY. No signs of an encampment or PEH were seen in the area.
