ACTIVITY REPORT FOR FEBRUARY 2024
MALIBU**

SCHOOL ISSUES

There was a PTA meeting at Malibu High School to discuss student-related safety.

INTERVENTIONS

A house visit and follow-up regarding a vandalism incident on the subject.
A male juvenile was cited for the vandalism incident that occurred in Malibu.

COMMUNITY / CRIMINAL ISSUES

1. The J-Team received calls from concerned citizens and parents regarding various juvenile issues in the community. We provided them with information about resource programs available in our community.
2. The J-Team contacted the Sylmar Juvenile Court DA for information on investigating and filing charges against juvenile offenders.
3. During the month, our unit met with Captain Seetoo to update her on current juvenile issues and investigations within the city.
4. The J-Team registered several young individuals in the Youth Diversion program for various offenses.
5. The J-Team assisted in preparing and filing court cases with the District Attorney's office as well as aiding other investigators with case preparation.
6. Meetings were held at the station with narcotic detectives to discuss drug-related and juvenile issues.
7. The J-Team handled the processing and follow-up of juvenile referrals regarding contacts between juveniles and uniform personnel.
8. The J-Team conducted the normal checks of juvenile problem areas in the city during weekend evenings and responded to juvenile-related calls for service.
9. The J-Team assisted patrol regarding CARP, backfilled behind patrol shortages, and worked mandatory overtime.
10. The DCFS office hosted a meet and greet with other law enforcement agencies.
11. The J-Team met with Fran Kenton regarding the Autonomie Program for challenged students.
12. The J-Team investigated a case of vandalism at an HOA in Malibu, the case is ongoing.
