

Dear Mayor Mullen:

This is in response to a letter dated November 8, 2018 in which the Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) provided the City of Malibu with a comment resolution package. The package included responses to submitted comments, revised Preliminary Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) panels, and a revised Flood Insurance Study (FIS) report. The letter specified a 30-day review period from the date of the letter for the City of Malibu to provide additional comments regarding the comment resolution and revised Preliminary FIRM panels and FIS report.

In an email correspondence dated November 14, 2018, the City of Malibu indicated the need for an extended period of review due to the recent wildfire and subsequent recovery efforts. Due to recent disaster and recovery efforts, FEMA will delay the deadline to submit comments until after the first of January 2019. The FEMA Regional Engineer will contact the City of Malibu during the first week of January, 2019, to discuss the review period and subsequent due date.

We appreciate your community's comments and commitment to having the most accurate flood hazard information available reflected on the FIRM and in the FIS report.
