

Effectuated By Woolsey Fire???

The Woolsey Fire was a destructive wildfire that burned in Los Angeles and Ventura counties. The fire began November 8, 2018 and burned over 98,362 acres destroying 1,643 structures, killing three people, and prompting the evacuation of more than 295,000 residents

- Supportive services Since some participants will be enrolled in training or education
