Malibu residents will have an opportunity to review the City's draft Strategic Plan on Homelessness on Thursday, May 24th at 7 p.m. at City Hall.

Residents will be able to ask questions and provide feedback on the plan before it goes to City Council for approval in June.

The Plan is designed to improve the effective use of existing resources, align our local efforts with those of the Los Angeles County region and balance the need to protect public safety while addressing the humanitarian and long-term needs of homeless individuals.

It is also meant to address immediate concerns and lay a foundation for tackling some of the more difficult aspects of homelessness in the future, such as the need for more affordable housing and mental health services.

We understand that homelessness has become an increasing concern in Malibu, and we want to be sure that our plan addresses these concerns.
