WHAT IS ACCEPTED

All recyclables except yard trimmings can be mixed together in your recycling cart

- Newspapers including inserts, newsprint publications
- Magazines including catalogs & glossy paper
- Junk mail including envelopes, white/colored office paper, junk/regular mail, binder paper, gift paper (no plastic/foil lining) & shredded paper
- Telephone books & catalogs
- Cardboard
- Cereal/cracker boxes (no liners)
- Brown paper bags
- Paper Egg cartons

- Glass food & beverage containers

- Aluminum cans
- Empty aerosol cans
- Aluminum foil
- Tin/metal cans
- Metal food trays
- Metal lids & caps from jars & bottles
- Empty, dry paint cans

- Narrow-necked plastic containers (any color) including soda bottles, detergent & shampoo bottles marked on the bottom with numbers 1-7
- All types of plastic bags

- Grass
- Leaves
- Weeds
- Brush
- Prunings less than 4' long and 6" in diameter
- Small branches
- Unpainted scrap lumber
- Fruit tree droppings
- Christmas trees cut to fit in cart (no flocking, decorations, tinsel or stand)

DO NOT INCLUDE

- Rubber bands or plastic wrap from newspapers
- Carbon paper or photographs
- Soiled paper (e.g. Kleenex)
- Books
- Thermal fax paper
- Plastic coated frozen food packaging or take-out containers

- Window glass
- Mirrors
- Light bulbs
- Fluorescent light tubes
- Dishware
- Vases

- Scrap metal
- Coat hangers*
- Propane tanks
- Computers
- Electronics

*return to dry cleaners

- Containers with plastic coating
- Plastics other than numbers 1-7
- Shrink wrap
- Toys
- Styrofoam
- Garden hoses
- Plastic pipes

- Trash
- Plastic, glass, cans or paper
- Poison oak, bamboo, palm fronds, cypress & iceplant
- Dirt or rocks
- Food or animal waste
- Prunings more than 4' long & 6" in diameter
