
Speed & Traffic Data Collection

Collection of data through a speed survey and traffic indicators to ensure the enforcement resources are being deployed appropriately.

Addition of Red Light Cameras as part of the Traffic Signal Synchronization Project for additional enforcement measures.

2015 PCH Safety Plan

The 2015 PCH Safety Plan Identified 130 projects. Below is an account of the Projects:

Completed - 7




Total Estimated Funding - \$52,139,719

City Improvements to PCH

The City of Malibu has initiated 5 additional projects not identified in the PCH Safety Plan in an effort to enhance public safety infrastructure.

Civic Center Way Improvement Project - \$5,200,000

PCH Bike Route Improvements - \$500,000

PCH at Kana Dume Intersection Improvements & Arrestor Bed - \$900,000

Under Construction

PCH Median Improvements - John Tyler to Puerco Canyon Road - \$6,950,000

Pending Funding

PCH Median Improvements - Webb Way & John Tyler
Estimated Cost - \$7,000,000
