City's Implementation of State Law:

Venues and Events Recycling Program

Pursuant to Integrated Waste Management Act of 2004 (Assembly Bill (AB) 2176)

California AB 2176 provides: "...each operator of a large venue or large event shall submit to the local agency, upon request by the local agency, written documentation of waste reduction, reuse, recycling, and diversion programs, if any, implemented at the large venue or large event, and the type and weight of materials diverted and disposed at that large venue or large event." The City has therefore implemented a mandatory Events Recycling Program to divert at least 50% of these highly recoverable materials from the landfill in accordance with AB 2176.

ATTENTION: The City has implemented a procedure to simplify this program. Effective July 1, 2005, event operators will be required to submit a *Recycling and Disposal Plan* included with their Special Event Permit or Temporary Use Permit application.

The City of Malibu requires that this Recycling & Disposal Plan be submitted at least 30 days before the start of any event, including the set up day(s) for the event. Any large venue or event must plan for the removal, disposal, and diversion of, and reporting of all recyclables and solid waste. It is required that 50% of all materials be diverted from landfills. A Recycling & Disposal Plan will be implemented to ensure that workers/volunteers comply with the 50% or higher diversion goal. The event operator should keep all documentation regarding the recycled, salvaged or reused, and land-filled materials for accurate reporting to the City.

Each event is required to account for all materials removed from the site and submit a Recycling & Disposal *Summary Report* along with hauling receipts from each landfill, facility or vendor to the Environmental Sustainability Department. Applicant shall submit a Summary Report within 10 days of end of the event.
